


Virtual School Special Education Choice Board – week of 4/20

<p>Reading Writing Activity Retell a story using a Virtual Read Aloud story</p> <p>Make a comic strip that retells a fictional story. Be sure to include; important events, characters, setting, conflict, resolution. Create a Comic Online</p> 	<p>Math Fraction, Decimal, Percent Create your own artwork on this 10 x 10 grid using up to 6 colors and determine the percentages of each color.</p> 	<p>Math: Play "I Spy" to find shapes around the house (ie. "I spy something that is orange and a circle). How many different shapes can you find in your kitchen?</p> 
<p>Reading Writing/Tracing/Typing Write a menu for the day. Make a list of items you like to request from the store. Write color words (red, orange, yellow, green, blue, violet, black, brown, white.) and write or type a food or item for each color.</p> <p>STRIPES</p> 	<p>Life Skills Activity Practice remembering your address and phone number, parent/guardians names and phone numbers in case of an emergency.</p> <p>HANDWRITING</p> 	<p>Math Rational Number War In a simulated game of War, help either Sarah or Serena win a given hand in the game.</p> 
<p>Reading Vocabulary: Sort pictures of food from a grocery store flyer or magazine into healthy foods, unhealthy foods and foods that should be eaten in moderation. Gather a bag of grocery items from around your house. Have your child put them where they go- talk about categories, properties, where they may be found in the grocery store (aisle, freezer, refrigerator?)</p> <p>STRIPES</p> 	<p>Reading Writing Activity Find a Prefix using a Virtual Read Aloud</p> <p>As you are reading, look for words that have a prefix. How does the prefix change the meaning of the base word? How many can you find?</p> 	<p>Math: Gather items from a grocery store trip and count how many cold food items and how many other items. Add them together to see how many in all.</p> $\begin{aligned} \text{Apple} + \text{Apple} + \text{Apple} &= 30 \\ \text{Apple} + \text{Banana} + \text{Banana} &= 18 \\ \text{Banana} - \text{Coconut} &= 2 \\ \text{Coconut} + \text{Apple} + \text{Banana} &= ?? \end{aligned}$

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
